The YWAM Nehemiah House, Inc. provides a Christ-centered home for female victims of sexual abuse, maltreatment, child prostitution and abandonment, between the ages of 7 - 18-years old. Currently, there are three centers: Cagayan de Oro, Malaybalay, and Gingoog City.

A House Parent at YWAM Nehemiah House, Inc. is fundamental in providing love, support and care to clients.

Responsibilities include:

- maintaining a good relationship with the children
- being a positive and consistent role model for the children
- assigning the children family responsibilities such as chores and assignments
- supervising the serving of meals
- teaching and encouraging good hygiene
- keeping children safe in the kitchen and other high-risk areas
- writing reports of any incidents or sicknesses and submitting them to the Social Worker
- maintaining a log book while on duty
- reporting any major incidents to the Center Manager
- attending PTA meetings and school functions of the children
- occasionally doing marketing when needed
- assisting the children with their homework and household duties
- giving basic medical attention when needed
- resolving conflicts between children when needed
- ensuring bible studies, God's Special Time, Praise and Worship and intercession
- implementing consequences for misbehavior from clients when needed
- performing other related tasks as necessary

Qualifications:

- College or University graduate
- Completion or a willingness to complete the Department of Social Welfare and Development Houseparent training
- Min. 22 years of age
- Good morals and conduct

Being a graduate of Youth With A Mission's (YWAM) Discipleship Training School (DTS) is an asset, but not a requirement.
